Format

This pack is available in a number of formats so that you can choose whichever works best for you. Different people have access to different equipment so we have tried to provide content that can be used with what most people are likely to have access to.

The pack is available as a printed version; on CD-ROM; or it can be downloaded from the Healthcare Sunday website at www.healthcaresunday.org.uk

The files are in Acrobat Reader PDF format because they are then self-contained with the fonts and graphics embedded, so that they will print as intended, rather than relying on you having anything other than Acrobat Reader on your computer.

The PDF files can be viewed and printed but not changed, though it is possible to copy text to paste into a document in another software program (e.g. Microsoft Word).

Printed version

The pages include colour but will still look good when photocopied in black and white. You can freely photocopy the pack for the purposes of Healthcare Sunday.

The printed overheads can be photocopied onto acetates (if they are the right type of acetate).

CD-ROM

The contents of the CD-ROM is shown below and can be accessed by opening the start.htm file in an internet browser (e.g. Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator) or by browsing the folders using Windows explorer.

When you insert the CD-ROM it will automatically open the start.htm file with your browser (unless you have autorun turned off on your computer). Just follow the links to access the papers you want and then print them out. The pages contain colour but still look good in black and white.

Resource packs from previous year's can be found in the archive folders.

System requirements

Operating system: any. Browser: Internet Explorer, Netscape Navigator or similar. To view files: Acrobat Reader (the installer for this can be found in the Software folder on the CD-ROM).
